

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

ASB: Anti-Social Behaviour

BCP: Borough Crime Picture – Police analysis of crime trends on the borough

BME: Black minority and Ethnic

CAD: ASB calls are recorded and dealt with in the police CAD (Computer Aided Despatch) control room

CAADA: Co-ordinated Action Against Domestic Abuse

DTOA: Drug testing on arrest – scheme that tests those individuals arrest for illegal drugs

IDVA: Independent Domestic Violence Advocacy Service

IOM: Integrated Offender Management – the scheme that is in place locally to target repeat offenders

iQuanta: Home Office database which records local authority crime statistics

LGBT: Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender

LPM: Local Policing Model – Metropolitan Policing Service has established a new approach to local policing. The LPM forms part of the Neighbourhood Policing segment of the One Met Model.

MARAC: Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference – the meeting that takes place to deal with high risk cases of domestic abuse

SAC: Serious Acquisitive Crime - Serious acquisitive crime is defined as domestic burglary (residence), theft of a motor vehicle, theft from a motor vehicle and robbery (people and business).

TNO's: Total notifiable offences - all crimes recorded during a certain time period
