## **GLOSSARY OF TERMS**

**ASB:** Anti-Social Behaviour

**BCP:** Borough Crime Picture – Police analysis of crime trends on the borough

**BME:** Black minority and Ethnic

**CAD:** ASB calls are recorded and dealt with in the police CAD (Computer Aided Despatch) control room

**CAADA:** Co-ordinated Action Against Domestic Abuse

**DTOA:** Drug testing on arrest – scheme that tests those individuals arrest for illegal drugs

**IDVA:** Independent Domestic Violence Advocacy Service

**IOM:** Integrated Offender Management – the scheme that is in place locally to target repeat offenders

iQuanta: Home Office database which records local authority crime statistics

LGBT: Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender

**LPM:** Local Policing Model – Metropolitan Policing Service has established a new approach to local policing. The LPM forms part of the Neighbourhood Policing segment of the One Met Model.

**MARAC:** Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference – the meeting that takes place to deal with high risk cases of domestic abuse

**SAC:** Serious Acquisitive Crime - Serious acquisitive crime is defined as domestic burglary (residence), theft of a motor vehicle, theft from a motor vehicle and robbery (people and business).

**TNO's:** Total notifiable offences - all crimes recorded during a certain time period
