
What is a bikehangar?

A bikehangar is a lockable bike storage facility that provides secure cycle parking for local residents who may not have space to store a bike at home. The bikehangar is installed onstreet, or on a wide section of footway, and can accommodate six bikes in the same area as half a single car parking space.





Why is the Council proposing to install Bikehangars?

The Council's Cycling Strategy aims to significantly increase the number of residents using a bicycle as their preferred mode of transport, particularly for local journeys. This is supported by the Mayor for London's Vision for Cycling. Bikehangars are designed to encourage cycling by providing a safe parking place to individuals who may otherwise be put off owning and using a bike in Richmond.

How does the scheme work?

Once bikehangars have been installed each of the 6 available spaces will be available to rent by local residents. The allocation of spaces would be on a first come first served basis. Residents will receive a key to their Bikehangar as well as a welcome pack outlining how to use the unit.

How much does it cost to rent a space?

There is a one-off £25 refundable deposit for a key and an annual rental fee of £72, which covers maintenance and servicing. Subscriptions can be cancelled at any time.
