Teddington Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), Zone T2 Extension Shaef Way Consultation – Questionnaire for Completion

In December 2022 the Council implemented the Teddington Controlled Parking Zone T2. The zone operates 10am to 12pm, Monday to Friday - see attached map.

Following the submission of a petition from residents of Shaef Way, the decision has been made to consult residents of this road on the option to join Zone T2. At the same time, we are also separately consulting all properties of Harrowdene Gardens on proposals to introduce new double yellow lines (no waiting 'At Any Time' restrictions) to improve access in this road and whether they would also wish to join the zone should proposals to extend the zone to Shaef Way be progressed.

If Shaef Way is added to Zone T2, residents and their visitors parking on street during the operational periods (10am to 12pm, Monday to Friday) will be required to purchase and display a valid parking permit. You will not be able to purchase a permit if you live in a property subject to a s106 Planning Agreement which restricts or prohibits the issue of permits.

Details of Zone T2 parking permit prices are as follows:

Permit Type	Cost
Resident	£63.80 per year
Resident Visitor	£1.65 per day
Business	£213.40 per year

Resident and Business permits

The above resident and business permit prices are for the first permit issued per household/business for one year. Subsequent resident permits purchased per year are approximately 100% more for the second permit and 200% more for the third and further permits issued. Subsequent business permits purchased are approximately 50% more for the second permit purchased per year and 50% again for third and further permits issued.

Resident visitor permits

Resident visitor permits (scratch cards) are available at half the standard price to the over 60s. These permits must be validated for the relevant time period. Please note that parking charges are reviewed annually.
