Dear Resident / Occupier

Implementation of new controlled parking zone – Cambridge Road / Elmfield Avenue area (new Zone T4)

In March 2022 I wrote to you to update you on the Council’s decision to implement new controlled parking zones (CPZs) in Teddington and preparations are underway aiming to bring these new schemes into operation later this year.

One of the new zones to be implemented is in the Cambridge Road/Elmfield Avenue area (new Zone T4) – see attached plan. This scheme will operate Monday to Friday 10am to Noon.

Due to the submission of a petition from residents of Cambridge Crescent and a low level of support from Westminster Close, these roads have been excluded from the scheme. It has, however, been decided to re-consult you, the residents of these two roads, once again to see if you would wish to be included in the scheme.

If the CPZ is extended to either or both Cambridge Crescent and Westminster Close, this would be in the form of a Parking Permit Area which involves less signage and line marking.

Parking Permit Costs

Resident and Business permits

The above resident and business permit prices are for the first permit issued per household/business for one year. Subsequent permits purchased per year are approximately 50% more for the second permit and 50% more again for the third permit issued.

Resident visitor permits

Resident visitor permits (scratch cards) are available at half the standard price to the over 60s. These permits must be validated for the relevant time period.

Should the results of this latest consultation show insufficient support for inclusion in the CPZ in one or both of these roads, that road or both roads could be excluded from the scheme and some displacement parking may occur. Being excluded from a CPZ also means that the properties concerned will not be eligible to apply for parking permits.

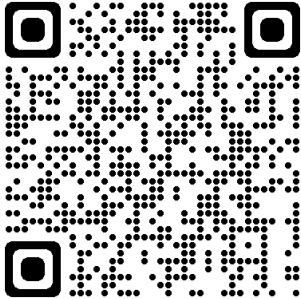
