## Whitton Central Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), Zone WC Review – Questionnaire for Completion

We are carrying out a consultation with all properties in the CPZ on how the scheme is working. This includes seeking views on whether the CPZ's operational hours/days are about right or need to be changed.

The current daytime operational hours/days, 10am to 2pm, Monday to Friday, are in Tier-1 as shown in the table below. The table indicates the current permit costs and how these could alter if the CPZ operational hours/days were to be changed.

All parking charges are reviewed annually.

At this time, we are not proposing any changes to the parking controls that solely operate 11am to 11pm when major event days are held at Twickenham Stadium. These hours take into account the various start and end times involved with the holding of these events (rugby matches, concerts etc). However, should you wish to provide feedback on these controls, these may be provided in the 'Further comments' section on the online survey.

## **Resident and Business permits**

The above resident and business permit prices are for the first permit issued per household / business for one year. Subsequent resident permits purchased per year are approximately 100% more for the second permit and 200% more for the third and further permits issued. Subsequent business permits purchased are approximately 50% more for the second permit purchased per year and 50% again for third and further permits issued.

## **Resident visitor permits**

Currently one resident visitor permit (scratch card) is required to be validated and displayed in a vehicle to allow parking for one day in Zone WC. In zones that operate for longer than four hours, two permits are required to allow parking for one day. These



permits are available at half the standard price to the over 60s. These permits must be validated for the relevant time period.

Please be informed that following requests received from residents, the Council is separately consulting properties in the Willowdene Close / Nelson Road area on the possibility of extending Zone WC. The Council is also reviewing the parking controls in Whitton High Street.
