




Breakdown of Crime Types

The top 3 offences in this period are Violence against the person, Theft and Vehicle Offenses, accounting for 67.6% of offenses.



During this period there is a no clear correlation between the increases and decreases in overall recorded crime. The lowest recorded crime was in April 2023 at 6.1 followed by small spike then the following 3 months 7.4 and in February 2024 another reduction 6.2. There is no evidence of significant increases or decreases across this period, the average offence rate is 2255 for all recorded crimes.








Breakdown of Crime Types



During this period there is a significant decline from 1.2 July 2023 to the lowest recorded Vehicle crime of 0.7 in February 2024. There then follows a slight increase.




Seasonality






General Trends

During this period there is a significant decline from a peak in September 2023 of 2.1 to the lowest recorded overall crime of 1.6 in December 2023 and January 2024.
