



St Mark's Playground Consultation, Phase 2

Following the initial round of consultation which was held in February to March 2018, where we asked for your views on a range of different types of equipment for St. Mark's Playground, we now want to understand the views of local residents and people who use St. Mark's Playground to help decide on the final design for the refurbished playground. Based on the results of the first round of consultation, three designs have been developed.

As St. Mark's Playground is on Common Land, we have strict guidelines regarding what can be done, which has also informed the three designs.

The style and height of any new equipment has to be sympathetic to the area and it will have to be appropriate for the age range of intended use. For St. Mark's Playground the intended age range is for children under 8 years old.

Once this consultation has closed, we will carefully consider all your feedback to decide on the final design. The final design will then be submitted for planning approval.

Please note that certain elements of the design may have to be altered during the implementation stage due to unforeseen technical or logistical issues.

The consultation will go live on **Friday 19 October 2018**.
